Rockville Science Day

When and where is Rockville Science Day? April 26, 2026 (tentative), Noon - 5:00 PM, at Montgomery College (Rockville campus). We're excited to celebrate the 35th year of Rockville Science Day in 2026!

How many people attend? Last year, we had approximately 4,000 visitors of all ages and over 100 exhibitors from across the region making it the largest STEM festival in Montgomery County.

What happens at Rockville Science Day? It's all about learning and fun! Our exhibitors (including government agencies, biotechs, universities, corporations, nonprofits, robotics teams, and interest groups) provide an opportunity for the public to interact directly with the scientific community and experience hands-on learning in a wide range of STEM fields. Visitors of all ages are engaged through the exhibits and many return year after year to explore and learn.

How can my organization/company get involved? In addition to serving as a sponsor of Rockville Science Day, there are many other ways to participate. Rockville Science Center

What is the Rockville Science Center and where are you located? The Rockville Science Center is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that was incorporated in 2009 as an outgrowth of the Rockville Consortium for Science which dates back to 1989. We have two locations in Rockville Town Square: our storefront (36C Maryland Ave) and the Rockville Makerspace & Tool Library (33F Maryland Ave).

What does your organization do? While Rockville Science Day is our flagship event, we work throughout the year to bring STEM education, maker programs, and mentorship opportunities to learners of all ages. Some of the programs we offer include classes (life science topics, robotics, programming, etc.), Summer of STEM Camps, Girls in STEM workshops, online lectures, field trips to local science-related sites, special interest clubs (math, chess, amateur radio), and high school engineering teams. Our Makerspace offers the community free access to a wide variety of tools and equipment, exciting maker classes, and a membership-based Tool Library. We are committed to making sure that our programs are affordable for all and offer scholarships to students who can demonstrate financial need. You can learn more at rockvillesciencecenter.org.
